



Mundaring DiscGolfPark



Welcome to the Mundaring DiscGolfPark. Disc Golf is played with similar rules to traditional golf, but instead of hitting a ball with a club players throw a flying disc (Frisbee). Disc golfers throw from a designated tee area to reach each hole in the least number of throws. The "hole" in Disc Golf is a raised basket with chains that catch the disc. The player who completes the course in the least number of throws is the winner.

The Disc Golf section of the Mundaring Sporting Club welcomes new members. The Disc Golf course is open to the public. The fee for non-members is \$10 per person, or \$20 per family. Please pay via the honour box around the far side of the building.

Disc Golf Rules:

1. Each player takes their initial throw from the tee area.
2. Subsequent throws are made from where the disc comes to rest.
3. The player farthest from the basket is the first player to take their next throw.
4. The hole is completed when the disc comes to rest with the basket or chains.
5. A run up and follow through are permitted unless within 10 meters of the basket.
6. Within 10 metres of the basket players must remain behind their lie until the disc comes to rest.
7. All discs must pass mandatory trees on the correct side. If the mandatory is missed, one penalty stroke is added to the score and the next throw is taken from the drop zone.
8. If the disc comes to rest in a tree, the next throw is taken underneath it with no penalty.
9. Remain quiet and avoid unnecessary movement while other players are throwing.
10. The player who completes the course in the least number of throws is the winner.

Safety:

1. Don't throw from the tee until other players or golfers have completed the hole.
2. Check that the way is clear before making a throw.
3. Please respect other course users and leave the course in good condition.
4. Players must act responsibly and play the course at their own risk.

Out of Bounds:

Out of bounds is marked throughout the course with pegs. All golf greens are out of bounds. All streams and water courses are out of bounds. A disc is only out of bounds if it comes to rest fully beyond the pegs, fully inside the golf green, or fully surrounded by water. A disc that comes to rest out of bounds is moved to within one metre from the point where it crossed the out of bounds line and one penalty stroke is added to the score.
